

Performance Measures Data Warehouse

The deadline for when states are required to report their LIHEAP performance measures data is fast approaching (January 2017). While many states continue to focus on the data collection and reporting, one of the underlying rationales for performance measurement is to enable states to evaluate their programs and consider adjustments to more effectively serve LIHEAP households. Accordingly, reporting and collecting performance measures data is not the end, but rather the beginning of a process of performance management.

1. Go to the LIHEAP Data Warehouse website:

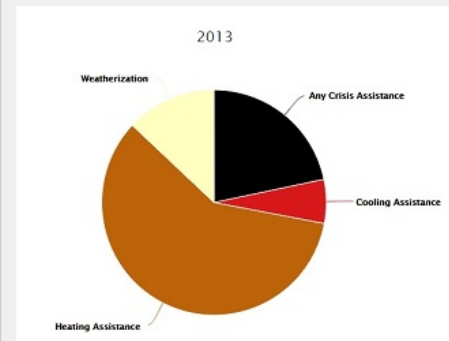

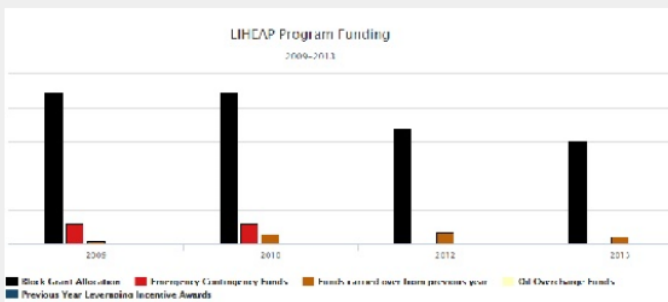

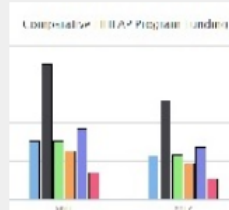
