PMIWG Overview

What the PMIWG Is: A working group that consists of a diverse group of state LIHEAP coordinators, state LIHEAP staff, and OCS staff.

PMIWG Mission: Help state grantees develop and implement methods for recording, collecting, tracking, analyzing, and using data for LIHEAP Performance Management.

Teams: PMIWG members have formed three teams (or committees) which tackle projects in a certain area. These include:

- **Data Case Studies Team:** This group finds different ways to spotlight grant recipients using data for program design and improvement.
- **Data Reliability Team:** Develops tools and resources to help grant recipients assess and improve the reliability of their data and reporting.
- **Performance Management Integration Team:** Creates tools and resources that help grant recipients incorporate performance management into their day-to-day work.

1. IT Solutions Survey

- APPRISE, OCS, and the PMIWG **finished drafting the IT Solutions Survey instrument** that will be administered to all LIHEAP grant recipients. This will collect data and report out on the types of IT solutions grant recipients use for various aspects of program administration.
- APPRISE and PMIWG members **conducted pre-tests of the survey instrument** with 7 states (with 2 more scheduled week of 9/16).

Recent Projects

1. LIHEAP Draft Training Tool/Project

- The PMI team is working with OCS to develop an online training tool for LIHEAP coordinators. The team recently developed the first set of three courses, which includes “getting started” material for newest coordinators.

2. Performance Measures “Next Steps” Tool

- Finish developing three more courses (at minimum)
- Roll out testing/review of LIHEAP Training Tool to grant recipients outside of the PMIWG.

2. Performance Measures “Next Steps” Tool

- Work with developers to test and provide feedback on tool (once staged online).
