Grant recipient audit oversight and monitoring coordination. Provides fiscal training and technical assistance as necessary

LIHEAP Operations Branch

Serves as grant recipient primary point of contact to provide training and technical assistance and oversight. Including grant application review, program monitoring and reporting oversite.

LIHEAP Data Policy and Evaluation Branch

Provides policy recommendations, annual formula allocation, grant recipient communication, customer inquiry review, website updates and submission of the Reports to Congress

LIHEAP funding allocations

- Current Continuing Resolutions (CR) expires March 14, 2025, at 11:59 p.m.
- Approximately 9% of unreleased LIHEAP funds will be awarded once congress releases full year budget.
- HHS Secretary Discretionary Reserve 1% of funding allocation
- Pause on federal funding Questions?
 - The Payment Management System (PMS) has all LIHEAP funds are currently available to drawdown.
 - Initial PMS delays
 - Clarifications about LIHEAP Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)

LIHEAP Forms Updates

Paperwork Reduction Act (PRA)

- Purpose: To improve the quality and practical utility of information required by the Federal government and reduce paperwork burden on the public.
 - Ensure data collected is accurate, helpful, and a good fit for the proposed uses(s)
 - o Ensure there aren't duplications in efforts across government.
 - o Ensure the public is informed about the information collected and its potential uses.



LIHEAP Form Updates Cont.

LIHEAP Performance Data Form

- Expired February 28, 2025.
- Requested extension to use current FY24 report.
- First Federal Register Notice published December 2, 2024.

Carryover and Reallotment Report

- Expires June 30, 2025.
- Requesting renewal of report.





LIHEAP Form Updates Cont.

LIHEAP Quarterly Report

- FY25 First Quarter Report due February 28, 2025.
- LIHEAP Quarterly Report expires October 31,2025.
- Will be submitted through PRA Information Collection Request.

LIHEAP Household Report (Long and Short Form)

- Expires March 31, 2026.
- Revisions are being made to comply with Executive Order.





LIHEAP Form Updates Cont.

- Residential Energy Consumption Survey (RECS) Data Match
 - Currently going through PRA process.
 - Action Transmittal will be issue to state grant recipient for household data match.
- Information Technology Solution Survey
 - Will be submitted through generic PRA process.





Financial Reporting Reminders

- FY 2023 Award:
 - Final FFR for LIHEAP due September 30, 2025.
- FY 2024 Award:
 - Initial/Interim FFR LIHEAP due December 30, 2024.
 - Final FFR for LIHEAP due September 30, 2026.
- FY 2025 Award:
 - Initial/Interim FFR LIHEAP due December 30, 2025.

REMINDER: All approval requests related to extensions for liquidation of funds or submission of FFRs must be approved by the grant management official listed on your award.



Financial Reporting Reminders



- Carryover and Reallotment Report
 - FY 2024 Award: Final/Revised Carryover Report Was Due December 30, 2024.
 - FY 2025 Award: Initial/Estimated Carryover Report Due August 1, 2025.

REMINDER: After your initial Carryover Report is submitted in August, you should ensure your final report is revised and submitted with accurate obligation data by December 31. Remember that you can always revise your submissions in Grant Solutions. FFR and Carryover Report obligation information should reconcile.



Monitoring Engagements

Federal FY 2023 and FY 2024 Updates:

- Only 2 of 10 Reports Remain Open with Unresolved Findings
- Only 3 of 12 Reports Remain Open with Unresolved Findings

Federal FY 2025 To Date:

- 8 States Monitored by OCS (4 CSBG, 3 LIHEAP)
 - 3 Reports Issued in Final
 - 2 Reports Issued in Draft
 - 3 Reports Currently Being Drafted

Uniform Administrative Guidance

- HHS <u>Interim Final Rule</u> prescribes how to apply new guidance at <u>2 CFR 200</u>
- HHS will phase in new guidance over the course of the next year
- The effective date of the new guidance for HHS awards is October 1, 2025
- Certain provisions for LIHEAP are effective October 1, 2024:
 - Increased indirect cost de minimis rate from 10 to 15 percent. This does not change the admin cap under LIHEAP.
 - Increased single audit threshold to \$1 million.
